**Day 2: Sacramento - Sierra Nevada Rail Journey - Lake Tahoe**

Today board an Amtrak Train for a **Sierra Nevada Rail Journey** through the beautiful snow capped Sierra Nevada Mountains to the Lake Tahoe area. Disembark your train in Truckee and board your motorcoach to drive to the spectacular year round resort area of **Lake Tahoe** to spend the next two evenings in the popular and revitalized South Lake Tahoe/Stateline area.

Meal - (B) Overnight: Lake Tahoe

**Day 3: Virginia City - Lake Tahoe Cruise**

This morning travel through historic Carson City, capital of the Silver State of Nevada enroute to visit **Virginia City**, site of the Comstock Lode and once the richest place in the world. The famous Old West town was once the west's mining metropolis and featured notable residents Mark Twain & Bret Harte. Later enjoy a **Lake Tahoe Paddle-wheeler Cruise** for spectacular views of picturesque Emerald Bay & the surrounding Sierra Nevada Mountains.

Meals - (B,D) Overnight: Lake Tahoe

**Day 4: Lake Tahoe - Death Valley**

Early this morning depart Lake Tahoe and enjoy the spectacular scenery of some of California's national forests enroute to **Death Valley**, the largest national park south of Alaska and known for extremes. It is North America's driest and hottest spot and has the lowest elevation on the continent—282 feet below sea level. There are rocks sculptured by erosion, richly tinted mudstone hills and canyons, luminous sand dunes, lush oases, and a 200-square-mile salt pan surrounded by mountains, one of America's greatest vertical rises. Upon arrival, check into your hotel for a two-night stay and enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers.

Meal - (B,D) Overnight: Death Valley

**Day 5: Death Valley National Park**

Today enjoy a full day to explore **Death Valley National Park**. Visit **Badwater Canyon**, the lowest spot in North America, at 282 feet below sea level and home to a surreal landscape of vast salt flats. At **Stovepipe Wells**, witness the ripples and patterns of the breathtaking sand dunes that rise 100 feet above the Mesquite Flat. Visit famous **Zabriskie Point**, an elevated overlook of a colorful, undulating landscape of gullies and mud hills at the edge of the Black Mountains where from the viewpoint, the flat salt plains on the valley floor are visible in the distance. Enjoy a relaxing **Farewell Dinner** this evening at the historic **Inn at Death Valley**, which opened in 1927. After dinner enjoy a **Stargazing Program** with a local expert.

Meals - (B,D) Overnight: Death Valley

**Day 6: Death Valley - Ash Meadows - Las Vegas**

This morning travel to **Ash Meadows National Wildlife Refuge**, a desert oasis with a rare and unique ecosystem. The refuge is home to nearly 30 species of plants and animals that do not exist anywhere else on earth, including desert fish that have existed since the time of the mammoths. Stroll the boardwalks and learn about the early pioneers, gunslingers and the mysterious Devils Hole that has never been found. Later travel and see the bright lights of modern **Las Vegas** for a one night stay.

**Day 7: Las Vegas - Home**
